March 20 – Latin Mass and Luncheon

- Everything is a go.
- Missy met with Brenda and confirmed the menu– Soup, Salad with two dressings, crackers/bread, cookies, coffee, lemonade and water. Brenda will be taking care of everything.
- Brenda and Angie Dillon are working together to get students to work in the kitchen with Brenda for service hours.

- Missy will meet with the Art Fair coordinators to determine the space allotted for the finger foods and drinks and the flow of people
- Hospitality Committee members are providing the Finger Foods (defined as anything that can be picked up with hands or stabbed with a toothpick) but will also call on family, friends, other parishioners to help provide these foods.

- need to determine what linens we will use for the food tables, paper products, etc. (discuss at next meeting)

May 15th – Centennial Banquet

- Missy shared with the committee members the contract with Ed

Pickens' for catering. It is fabulous!

- Bernadette Krehnovi declined the offer of doing the cakes; Missy has contracted with someone else that she is familiar with to do the cakes.
- Missy talked with Bill Collins at Kingwood about what was growing in 1911; Bill gave Missy some ideas for native plants that might have been in this area. After discussion about vases and cut flowers, the committee decided to do small potted plants for centerpieces and candles. Missy will talk with Possum Run about buying the plants from them. Committee members wanted to be sure that we **bought** the plants from them because they are so generous to the Parish. **(discuss at next meeting)**
- a great idea was given to ask Serra members or any parishioner who would like to sponsor a religious person for the dinner. Committee members also said they would also be happy to sponsor someone for the dinner.
