Old Business:

Banners-there are 10 of them. There are more than 500 squares in each banner. The quilt committee started working in September. They met every two weeks, skipping December. They finished March 12th. The committee still wants to make some kind of bag/tote for the rolled banners to protect them and help transport them.

Hospitality - Missy wanted to know if there will be an "official photographer" for the centennial events. Suggested were Dave Fleming, Dave Androw. Rich Krehnovi, Kathy Anatra, Claudia Raff.

Missy requested 3 festival booths for the Ice Cream Social. She should contact Terry Philpott.

There will be a paper program for the banquet. We will do it ourselves.

The art show will need several serving tables. Ticket cost for the attending priests and religious for the banquet will be covered by donors.

Church Tours- started March 12 and 13. There were 6 people after the 5:00 Mass and 12 people after the 11:30 Mass. The dates for these are listed in the bulletin. Angie will put a reminder on the bulletin board the weekend before the scheduled tours.

Art Show/Centennial Mass-Kim Quick is with her mother who is ill. She is making a set of altar vessels and these will be in the art show.

Art Show-Frank has several pieces to enter. There will be a bulletin reminder for March 19 and 20 for entries for the show and banquet tickets. We can also do a bulletin insert if needed.

Commemorative Book and DVD-Amy Secrist is working on the parish history/update for this. There are 25 sponsors so far. (\$400.00 at \$25.00 per line)

Fr. Lutz/Jubilee Museum in Columbus-is sending items for a display in the art show. It will include items from Bishop Ready, an alumnus of St. Peter's. Angie suggested that information about the art show be available at the Art Center, downtown galleries and Richland Academy.

Centennial Liturgy-the Committee has not yet met. Angie wanted to know what readings would be used for the Mass. Bill said readings for the dedication of a church.

Paschal Candle - The Paschal Candle using the watercolor design will cost about \$900.00. The cost is being covered by the family/estate of our Root Candle Co. rep.

Memorabilia-Sweatshirts and tee shirts will be here in two weeks. They feature the watercolor design on the front and the centennial prayer on the back. There will also be a cotton shirt design. Notecards continue to be a big seller.

Volunteers- names are still coming in.

Tridentine Mass-Members of Liturgy Committee will be greeters. There will be a handout to help understanding. It's a teachable moment/educational. Communion will only be on the tongue. Fr. Tom will help with the distribution of communion. Bob Kasper has been invaluable in making this happen.

Cornerstone-the cost will be the deciding factor.

Publicity-Heart of Ohio Magazine and Family Magazine are helping spread the word.

Centennial Prayer-All had received a copy of this. Bill provided a copy of St. Peter's Key article containing Bishop Ready's Sermon for the Parish Centennial dated Nov. 1946.

Parade-planning committee met. There is now a form for marching units and other participants. These are available in the Parish Office. The parade will include Boy Scouts, the local Air Guard as the honor guard, a corvette and a white horse.

DVD update-we still need to do 16 interviews. A short list of questions is provided. Help is needed to finish this project.

New Business

Invitations and Response-We have the apostolic blessing and a proclamation from the governor. We have 20 former pastors, former associate pastors and sons of the parish, attending plus Fr. Tony and Fr. Tom. Bishop Blair may still attend. He is reviewing his schedule.

Beverly Brook, Elementary Music Teacher, has written a special song called entitled "One Hundred". The Children's Choir will perform at the centennial mass.

Mass - We will need a worship resource and greeters.

Bob Keller/Timeline-the 8th graders are doing projects around this. It will probably be put in the high school halls during the art show. The 8th grade Publications Class is working on w self-guided tour (script and brochure). Kathy is looking into getting some iPads for the tour. Kathy will write the Bernat/Milligan Family about the festivities.
