**Minutes:** clarified Soup for the Soul following the Tridentine Mass on Mar. 20<sup>th</sup>.

**Church Tours:** Angie – Sr. Paula and Angie will meet to schedule. Their plan is to have church tours after 11:30 mass during January and February and add tours after 5:00 mass in March, April and May.

**Sr. Paula** – paragraph from Cincinnati Catholic Telegraph. We were part of a mission area in 1842-1846. We are only mentioned once in a letter. There is a church report in the Cleveland Diocese for Dec. 20, 1911.

**Jenny Pennell**-has been working with John Thrasher. The medallion project still has issues. The cost would be \$60-\$75. Idea has been tabled for the time being.

**Bob Kasper:** Fr. Joe is anxious to come to St. Peter's in March for Tridentine Mass.

**Sheila Finnerty** – St. Mary's in Hudson has offered help. They made a grotto out of stone. They sold a Christmas ornament. Their time capsule contained a DVD and player with cords. It was constructed of plexiglass placed in the wall of the church so that it was visible to visitors. (Jackie Kurtz, our elementary/junior high choir director is from the Hudson parish.) They also created a children's mural of tiles. They had a trolley tour of their cemetery. They incorporated Social Action into their centennial celebration.

be matching candles for the ambo and altar. These may be a gift from the Root Candle Co.
