C. Reports

Hospitality/Missy Saprano – She has reserved Mid-Ohio Conference Center for Sunday, May 15 at 5:00. The cost of the banquet dinner will be \$3.50. They will be using the original menu. There are 12 people on the committee so far. Ed Pickens has been contacted for catering. They will be meeting Nov. 4th at 6:30 p.m. in the atrium. The Ice Cream Social will be Friday, May 13th at 6:30 p.m. in the church parking lot. The cost is \$2.50. There is no BINGO that night. Saturday, May 14th is the Art Show in the Bob Frye Gym during the day. Finger foods (cheese) and punch. (Some hospitality should be arranged for visiting clergy before the Mass on May 15th.)

***Some things for the rest of the year: March 20th 2:00 p.m. in church **Tridentine Style Mass (the Extraordinary Form)** celebrated by Fr. Joe Szybka. Bob Kasper will serve if needed. Should Liturgy Committee have their Soup For The Soul after and should we ask Fr. Joe to give a short reflection on Eucharist? Core staff has some concern about having this Mass at St. Peter’s. Only Fr. Joe has the authorization to have the Mass and there is no longer a relic in the high altar.
