The pasta dinner — \$6 for adults and \$3 for children — will be 4 to 7 p.m. Saturday.

The barbecue chicken dinner — \$7.50 to eat in and \$8 for take-out — will be noon to 4 p.m. Sunday. The chicken dinner will be available in a drive-through area at the festival entrance. Homemade cakes and pies will be sold in the dining room Sunday.

There will also be sandwiches, French fries, soft drinks, pizza, and other food items sold at the snack shack on Saturday and Sunday.

The format of the grand prize raffle will be the same as last year to give more players a chance to win. There will be a total of six cash prizes. The grand prize is \$3,000, 2nd prize is \$2,000, 3rd is \$1,000, with 4th through 6th prizes worth \$500

each. Players need not be present to win. Tickets are \$1 each, six for \$5, or 12 for \$10 and will be sold at the festival. Chances to win an Italian dinner for four hosted by St. Peter's Priests , can also be purchased at the festival raffle booth.

All proceeds from the festival benefit the school .

Golf carts will shuttle those needing assistance from the Value City parking lot to festival grounds. A children's area will feature three inflatable rides; one or two-day ride wristbands will be sold in addition to individual tickets.

A general store craft raffle booth will offer chances to win handcrafted jewelry and other handmade works of art as well as gift packages.
