The General Fund - Many people choose to make their charitable contributions directly to the General Fund, wishing the earnings to be distributed as needed by the many, varied and changing needs of St. Peter's Schools.

The Specific Funds - Many people choose to make their charitable contributions directly to one of the Foundation's established Specific Funds. Currently the Foundation has the following Specific Funds available for contributions.

Scholarship Fund to provide scholarships to Catholic Students who desire to attend St. Peter's Schools but whose parents are unable to pay all or a portion of the actual tuition costs.

Library Fund to keep St. Peter's Grade School and High School Libraries up to date and competitive with public school libraries.

Technology Fund to keep the Grade School and High School technology equipment and software up to date.

Teacher Advanced Education Fund to provide teachers with the opportunity to enhance their knowledge and teaching skills through seminars and/or lectures.

Fine Arts Education Fund to promote fine arts to students attending St. Peter's Schools.

Science Education Fund (Sister Bernard Marie Fund) to promote high quality science programs at St. Peter's Schools.

Math Education Fund to assure that St. Peter's students obtain the highest quality math education.

Language Education Fund to assure that students at St. Peter's are taught effective communications skills.

Special Education Fund to enhance the education of special needs students.

Montessori Fund to promote the Montessori concept of teaching pre-schoolers.

Student Community Involvement Fund to provide the funds needed for students to carry out assistance programs for the poor and needy in the community.

Teacher Salary Enhancement Fund to promote the hiring and retention of quality teachers by offering competitive salaries.

Athletic Fund to promote a variety of sports activities at St. Peter's Schools as well as maintain sports equipment and facilities.

School & Grounds Maintenance Fund to provide additional funds to help keep buildings and grounds clean and safe.

Children's Daycare Program Fund to provide high quality Christian daycare services in a safe, clean environment.

Grade School Fund to help provide additional financial assistance to operate St. Peter's Grade School.

High School Fund to help provide additional financial assistance to operate St. Peter's High School.

The 20/20 Vision

Campbell have joined efforts to initiate the first planned giving program on behalf of The Dunn Foundation.

Over the years, it has become very apparent to all of us at St. Peter's that the parish financial ability to continue to operate St. Peter's Schools on a long term basis is directly linked to The Dunn Foundation's success in substantially increasing its assets.

It is always difficult to ask our supporters for more contributions, as you are already very generous with your time, energy, talent and money. However, this planned giving program - The 20/20 Vision - is a different type of request. It is an opportunity for you to give a substantial gift now or at your death that will permanently provide for the future security of St. Peter's Schools.

This is not a gift that will disappear into a school operating budget or a building improvement. On the contrary, each year in perpetuity, the income from your gift will be available to help St. Peter's continue its quality educational programs in a Catholic environment. A gift to The Dunn Foundation is a good way for you to help perpetuate your Catholic faith.

The 20/20 Vision goal is to obtain \$20 million dollars in Foundation assets in twenty years. We can do this, but we will need your help to make it happen. It's a good way for you to perpetuate forever your presence and that of your loved ones in the life of St. Peter's Schools.

As you think about your pledge to The Dunn Foundation, keep in mind that the State of Ohio has recently reduced the estate tax bill you pay at your death. For example, an estate of \$100,000 to \$300,000 received a reduction in estate taxes of approximately \$3,000 to \$9,000. This is money the state was taking from you at death that will no longer be taken. Hopefully, you will consider using that tax reduction to make a gift to the Foundation at your death.

This planned giving program, The 20/20 Vision, will officially begin May 1, 2003. Committee members will be contacting you for your planned giving. Keep in mind, yours can be a commitment that takes effect now or in the future by making The Foundation a beneficiary in your Will or Trust.
