**JHAD Report:** Bob Keller turned in 2 requests; 1) Jr. High Softball - \$98.16 for softballs, scorebooks, practice bat & batting glove. 2) 7/8 grade Basketball Team - Ashland Univ. (Jr. High) Summer League (7 wk. league) entrance fee \$ 250.....wants Boosters to pay for 1/2.

Pat Dropsey made a motion to pay all of the softball request and 1/2 of the basketball request. Rick Faulk 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor.

**HSAD Report:** Tim Failor was not in attendance. There was a baseball game (away). Jeff Thompson was not in attendance either, but had emailed Carla for a request to pay the June Ball Baseball Umpires \$50 for the few home games scheduled. Rand Smith made a motion to pay half of the cost, Pat Dropsey 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All in favor.

### **New Business:**

**Centennial Parade** ~ Carla asked if the Booster Members were interested in participating (making a float) for the parade on May 15. Dana Haag volunteered to chair this float project. Jenny Berick said she would help. Rand suggested to have some student athletes ride on the float while other athletes walk along the sides; include cheerleaders.

**Baccalaureate Request** ~ Carla submitted a request from the 2011 Baccalaureate Committee asking for a donation for the reception to honor the graduates & their families. Since this was not an athletic event, Rand Smith made a motion to turn down the request. Pat Dropsey 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor.

**Art Varga Soccer** ~ Art asked for the Booster's endorsement/backing for the upcoming Boys/Girls K-8 Youth Soccer Camp. The cost is \$20 per athlete (includes t-shirt, ball, water bottle) and he was asking for ½ of the cost. Rand Smith made a motion to pay half the cost per athlete so the parent/athlete pay for the remaining half. Rick Faulk 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor.

The left over revenue would go back to the Boosters and could be donated to the upcoming Spartan Super Scrimmage (boys soccer) on August 13<sup>th</sup>. Dana will email Art the Spartan Booster logo so he could have it printed on the water bottles. Art stated that an athletic trainer is needed for this event. Dana Haag suggested he call the Mansfield Ambulance Service, because she used them when she organized an alumni basketball game. They did not charge a fee. Dana will email Art the booster logo and the person's name who he should contact @ Mans. Ambulance.

The Alumni Soccer Game is scheduled for August 6<sup>th</sup>.

**Facebook Group** ~ Carla urged everyone to join the St. Pete's Athletic Booster Club's group page on Facebook. Carla and Dana will be posting information regarding upcoming events. She encouraged everyone to post this onto their personal page so promote the Booster Club's group page.

cost, but Rand said that he appreciated her enthusiasm, he'll just have them do it. Dana painted 2 coats in the inside of one dugout last year.

Mary Smith made a motion to adjourn, Rand Smith 2<sup>nd</sup> it.
