January 13, 2010 School Commission Report

1. Catholic Schools Week will be held from January 31 to February 6. As of now, the following are the scheduled activities for the week.
  - Sunday, January 31 – St. Peter's Parish Concert Series Catholic Schools Week Concert. This concert will feature our own St. Peter's students, including the Minisingers. The concert will take place at 3:00 p.m. in St. Peter's Church.
  - Monday, February 1 – History of St. Peter's School. A DVD presentation to students in grades 1-6 about the history of St. Peter's School. Presenters include Sr. Bernard Marie and Sr. Paula. The assembly will take place in the afternoon (time yet to be determined).
  - Tuesday, February 2 – Catholic School Week Liturgy at 9:00 a.m. for grades 1-12.
  - Wednesday, February 3 – Mansfield Symphony Orchestra Ensemble Performance (Brass Trio) concert (12:45 for grades K-2 and 1:35 for grades 3-5)
  - Thursday, February 4 – "Dignity for All" assembly. This assembly will focus on respect (9:45 for grades 2 and 3, and 10:30 for grades 4-6). Mr. Frank DiLallo from the Toledo Diocese is the presenter.
  - Friday, February 5 – Student Appreciation Day. Students may be out of dress code on this day.
  
2. The end of the second quarter is Friday, January 22. Report cards will be distributed to students on Friday, January 29. Parent/Teacher/Student Conferences will be held in the elementary school on Thursday, February 4 from 4:30 to 8:00 p.m.
  
3. The Curriculum Committee recently concluded their meetings and has made recommendations/suggestions to the principals. The recommendations/suggestions will be shared with members of the School Commission at tonight's meeting. I have already presented the recommendations/suggestions to members of the elementary school's Administrative Assistance Team and will discuss these in detail with this group at our January meeting (January 13 at 3:20 p.m.). 4. The Fine Arts Festival will be held on Wednesday, April 28. This date is not on the school's yearly calendar but has been placed on the "all-event" Parish/School calendar.

I have reminded parents in several recent letters about this year's early registration period. **As has been done in previous years, a \$100 per child registration fee (not to exceed \$200 per family) will be required from all current families for enrollment in Montessori through grade twelve.** This

year's Open House will be held on Sunday, February 7 from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m.. It is very important for current families to enroll before the Open House date because at that time new registrations will be accepted, filling remaining class openings. Currently, grade two is at capacity enrollment and grade four is near capacity enrollment.
