

## FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR IN GENERAL

All supplies should be clearly labeled with the student's name.

Students should have a book bag or gym bag to carry books to and from school each day. These may not be used to carry books to classes during the day.

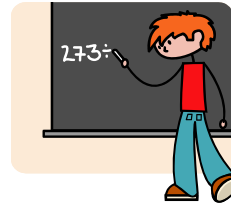

### Physical Education Dress Code Policy

All students must wear gym shoes with laces and non-scuff soles. These shoes must be clean and the soles free from dirt and/or mud. Junior High students are required to change into clean and comfortable gym clothes: shorts, sweatpants, sweatshirts and T-shirts. These clothes should be clean and neat, not tattered. No cutoffs, jean shorts, jeans, boxers, shorts with snaps or zippers, pajama bottoms or tops, or sleeveless shirts. Shirts must be long enough to be tucked and stay tucked. Shirts with logos or printing must be appropriate for a class setting. Socks and shoes should be brought for class and not worn at other times during the school day. Designated school uniform clothing is not permitted in gym class.
