

## **ST. PETER'S ADMISSIONS POLICY**

Within the categories below, the date of registration will determine acceptance according to the following priority list:

1. Students currently enrolled in St. Peter's Daycare, Montessori, Elementary, Junior High, and High Schools.
2. Siblings of students currently enrolled in St. Peter's Daycare, Montessori, Elementary, Junior High, and High Schools whose parents or guardians are active parishioners of St. Peter's or Resurrection Parish. An active parishioner is one who is registered with the parish, demonstrates commitment to the Catholic faith by regularly attending weekly liturgy, volunteers time or service in a parish or school ministry and provides regular financial support to the parish to the best of his/her ability.
3. Siblings of students currently enrolled in St. Peter's whose parents or guardians are non-parishioners.
4. New students whose parents or guardians are active members of St. Peter's or Resurrection parishes.
5. New students from other Catholic parishes.
6. New students whose parents are non-parishioners.

Dates of enrollment:

1. Existing school families will receive forms for registration prior to the March Open House date.
2. Registration forms must be completed and returned to school by March 4, 2012 along with a \$100 non-refundable fee per child, not to exceed \$200 per family (which will be deducted from your tuition) in order to ensure a place for the following school year.
3. Tuition fee will only be refunded if the enrolled student has moved outside the geographical limits which prohibit attending St. Peter's.
4. Open House will take place on the first Sunday in March. On this date, registration will be open to the general public and new students will be accepted based upon the admission policy above until classes are filled.
5. After the Open House date students will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis until classes are filled.
