ACTIVE PARISHIONER PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

Providing quality Catholic education has been a part of St. Peter's Parish from its foundation. As a parish, we make a substantial financial investment in this ministry – a responsibility that is shared by every parishioner and local participating Catholic parishes.

St. Peter's Parish subsidizes the "per pupil cost of education" for *every* student enrolled in St. Peter's School. Catholic parishioners whose children are enrolled in our school system receive the added benefit of a parish subsidy beyond the cost of tuition and financial assistance.

For this reason, it is expected that parishioners whose children are enrolled in St. Peter's School, ***and who desire to receive the "parishioner rate" for tuition, will commit to the following:***

- At least one parent is a practicing Catholic, and is registered at St. Peter's Parish or one of the area participating Catholic parishes.
- Parents/Guardians and child(ren) participate in Sunday Mass weekly. "School begins on Sunday."
- Contribute to the Sunday Offertory collection. [At St. Peter's, Sunday offering envelopes can be mailed to you upon request, or direct debit/electronic fund transfer can be arranged by contacting our Parish Center at 419.524.2572].
- Participate in the life of your parish, volunteering 40 hours of service per year, in parish ministries, at parish or school events, or participation on committees.
